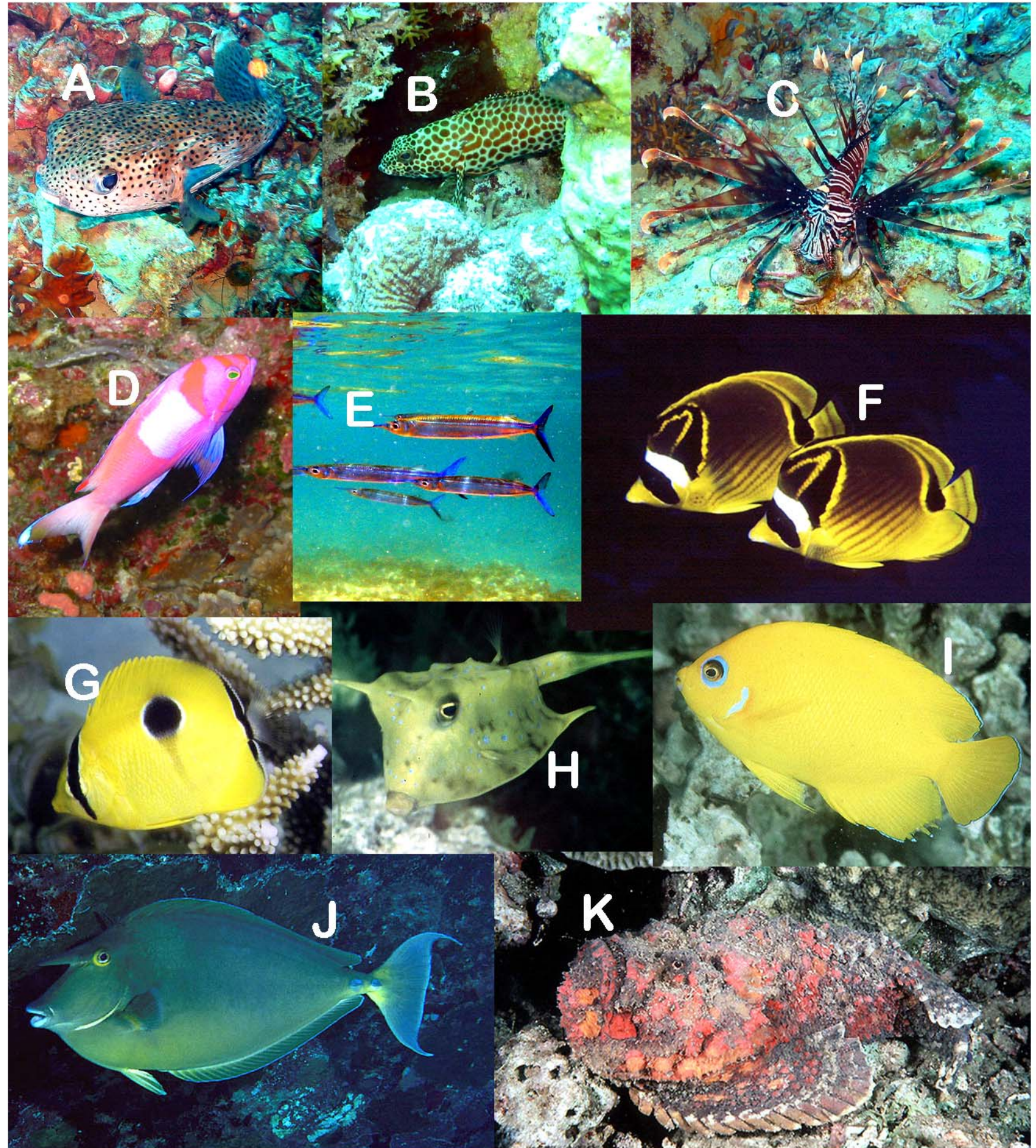


# Give Me A Clue!

2. I have two horns on my head, like a cow, that's why they call me a *cowfish*.
3. I am a *honeycomb grouper*. The spots on my body could easily be mistaken for a bee's home.
4. I look just like a rock, that's why I'm called a *stonefish*.
5. I resemble a sour fruit, where I get my name, the *lemon peel angel fish*.
6. I am a *porcupine fish*. I have spikes just like the real porcupine.
7. Because my spot looks like it's runny, they call me the *teardrop butterfly fish*.
8. Sometimes I am called a zebrafish or a turkeyfish because of my stripes, but I am also known as a lionfish because it looks like I have a lion's mane.
9. I am called a *squarespot anthias* because my spot is shaped like a box.
10. I wear a mask just like a raccoon's, that's why I'm a *raccoon butterfly fish*.
11. I am the *blue-spined unicorn fish* because of my blue colored tail spines. I am better known as the *tataga* in the CNMI .
